



"Bangladeshi-discovery – With a Twist"

Being spoilt for choice in Bridgnorth, one needs an excuse to select from one of the many Pan-Asian restaurants on offer, and great service, excellent value and of course depth of flavour, not to mention the 'Saros Twist' certainly swings it for me.

Tucked away up moat street, Bridgnorth, it's easy to forget Saros Bangladeshi restaurant, unless you appreciate depth of flavour and knowledge of ingredients. Once visited never forgotten (and amazingly, nor is your name!)

The décor is contemporary in style, as is the food – the owner 'Saj' and his team are very knowledgeable about the ingredients, and are happy to adapt dishes to suit your needs and personal tastes. We had booked on a Wednesday night, and were pleasantly surprised to discover it is one of their 2 for 1 nights, as well as Sundays, which explains why it was so full. To start we decided to go for the sharing platter – Lamb Tikka, Tandoori King Prawns, Chicken Tikka, Sheek Kebab, and onion Bhajee's, also accompanied with their ample serving of half a roasted pepper filled with roasted vegetables –It seems enough for 4, but who's counting? Each selection was flavoursome, clearly marinated, and perfectly cooked.

The mains were chosen from a wide selection of specials, including fish, a specials board, and the 'chefs recommended favourites' – an eclectic mix of exotic specials with what they call the 'Saros Twist', as well as an extensive, well priced menu. I chose the Chicken Mango Chilli Massala £6.95 and my guest the King Prawn Dansak £7.95 – for sides Saj recommended Sag Paneer (spinach and Indian cottage cheese) and Palak Basmati Rice- an aromatic combination with garlic, fried spinach, butter and herbs. The restaurant, though small, is perfectly formed – whereas the dishes are large, and equally perfect – No skimping on the portions here, even on 2 for 1 night. There is always a good atmosphere, and the daily specials on the blackboard are worth a try for the more adventurous. We also enjoyed a bottle of Cobra beer, and one of their very well priced house wines.
